Frequent Flyer Survey:

Traveling Post-COVID-19

Summer 2021



Executive Summary

Xenophon Analytics conducted its periodic Frequent Flyer Survey, using the firm's proprietary Frequent Flyer Database which is made up of more than 200,000 opt-in frequent flyers from across the United States.

This survey focused on pandemic issues as they impact travel including questions on vaccine passports and vaccine hesitancy. Nearly 65% of frequent flyers report that a vaccine passport would increase their confidence in the safety of air travel. While 90% of frequent flyers either fully or partially vaccinated against the virus, nearly one in 10 frequent flyers stated that will not get vaccinated.

Results show a divide between Republican and Democratic respondents. Only 46% percent of Republicans reported that a vaccine passport would increase their confidence in the safety of air travel, while 93% of Democrats believe that verifying vaccine status would increase passenger safety.

Additionally, Republicans and Democrats disagree on a vaccine passport mandate by either the federal government or the airlines. The specific questions addressing this issue were:


The survey had 2,000 respondents who are self-described members of loyalty programs of major U.S. airlines including Delta, United, Southwest, American, JetBlue, Alaska, and others. The survey was conducted from July 26 through August 12, 2021 and has a margin of error of +/- 2%.

Topline demographic information of survey participants:

- 65% over the age of 60
- 56% male
- 75% white
- 32% Democrats
- 29% Republican
- 28% Independents



Before the COVID-19 pandemic, how many times per year did you travel by plane on average?





Question 2 How many airline frequent flyer programs do you belong to?





Question 3Which airline do you fly most frequently?





Question 4 How do you book the majority of your tickets?









How many trips by plane have you taken since Jan. 30, 2020, when the World Health Organization declared COVID-19 a public health emergency of international concern?





Question 8What was the nature of those trips?





Question 9 Do you have any plans to travel by plane in the next six months?





If you are planning to travel, are those trips for business or personal?





Question 11 If you are planning to travel for personal reasons, what is the reason?





Question 12 How would you rate your level of confidence that air travel is safe?






Would a "vaccine passport" increase your confidence in the safety of air travel?


Would you support a government requirement to provide airport security proof of vaccination (vaccine passport) in order to be able to travel on an airplane?



Would you support a commercial airline requirement to provide proof of vaccination (vaccine passport) in order to be able to travel on an airplane?





Have you received one of the CDC-approved COVID-19 vaccines (Pfizer, Moderna, or Johnson & Johnson)?









If traveling, would you use commercial ground transportation (eg. Uber, Lyft) to or from the airport?





One a scale of 1 to 5, how much would the amount of people at the destination airport affect your decision to travel?





Has COVID-19 caused you to either cancel or postpone travel plans?









Would deploying touchless or contactless tech in airports provide you with some peace of mind when traveling?





Where would touchless or contactless tech in airports be most beneficial? (Select all that apply)







Do you think that the COVID-19 pandemic has made the integration of touchless or contactless tech into our everyday lives more acceptable?







Question 31What is your age range?






Question 32What is your gender?







Question 33What is your race or ethnicity?




